

FREIGHT TRAIN GAME INSTRUCTIONS

For two players.

Beginner Level (If playing with an adult and child, start the child out on the un-numbered train.):

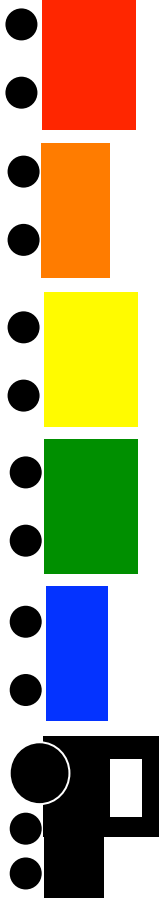
1. Place your conductors on the cabooses.
2. Take turns rolling the die.
3. If you roll a one, move your conductor forward one train car and say "one." If you roll a two, move your conductor forward two cars and say "one-two."
4. The first one to reach the engine wins!

Advanced Level (when children are more comfortable with the names of numerals):

1. Place your conductors on the board behind the cabooses (on the non-existent "zero" space).
2. Take turns rolling the die.
3. If you roll a two, move your conductor forward two cars and say "one-two." If your next roll is also a two, move your conductor forward and say, "three-four." If the next roll is a one, move your conductor forward and say, "five" and so on.
4. The first one to reach the engine wins!

Variations:

- change the die to a 1-2-3 die by changing two sides to 3-dots (so there are two 1's, two 2's and two 3's.)
- solitaire mode: one person plays both trains to see which train wins.
